









WEEKLY MEETING 24 JAN 2023

The weekly meeting was graced by **Mr. Umakant Chavan**, a distinguished wildlife explorer and nature conservation activist. His impassioned discourse delved into the biodiversity of the Western Ghats, emphasizing the significance of preserving **Devraai—a sacred grove** associated with temples.

Umakant illuminated the historical connection between **Devraai and forest conservation**, elucidating how these groves were designated as holy places to safeguard the surrounding forests, fostering the preservation of medicinal plants and biodiversity. However, he expressed concern about the contemporary trend where people have shifted focus from forest conservation to **temple-centric activities**. Temples have expanded, while forests have diminished.

The speaker highlighted the imperative need to conserve existing forests, dispelling misconceptions about indiscriminate tree plantation. Umakant emphasized that merely covering land with trees is insufficient, underscoring the importance of preserving diverse ecosystems.

The session culminated with an engaging Q&A, with Umakant fervently addressing queries from the attentive audience.

Birthday and anniversary celebrations added a festive touch to the meeting, with **Rtn. Amol Ghodake** being the lucky Rotarian. **Rtn. Dr. Mahadeo Mane** expressed gratitude in the vote of thanks, acknowledging the insightful discourse and interactive session that enriched the weekly gathering. IPP Rtn.
